On May 22, 2008, Jonathan & Susan Brandler were honored with the Anita & Stanley Hirsh Award for Outstanding Community Leadership by the Jewish Family Service of Los Angeles (JFS). JFS is the first charity to be established in Los Angeles in 1854. They assist over 60,000 people annually, regardless of religion or ethnicity, in areas such as poverty, hunger, family violence, depression, alcohol & drug abuse, immigration & resettlement, and homelessness.
